#### **Tuition fees**

Students whose tax residence is in the European Economic Area pay fees according to a sliding scale, from €0 to €10,370/year for the undergraduate programmes and from €0 to €14,270 for the Master's programmes (for the academic year 2018-2019). This calculation is based on the total declared family income and size of the household. These students may use the online calculator to estimate fees directly.

Students whose tax residence is not in the European Economic Area will pay fees of  $\epsilon$ 10,370/year for the undergraduate programmes and  $\epsilon$ 14,270 for the Master's programmes (in 2018-2019).

Every year, nearly a third of students pay zero tuition fees. Institution-specific initiatives allow students to benefit from exemptions under certain conditions.

To allow its students to devote all of their energy to their studies, Sciences Po offers substantial <u>financial aid</u> to those in need. French and European students receiving the CROUS scholarship are not only exempt from paying tuition, but also receive a significant top-up grant from Sciences Po.

Students from outside the European Economic Area may apply for <u>many scholarships</u> including the <u>Émile Boutmy excellence scholarship</u>, named after the founder of Sciences Po (1872). Over 250 students receive this prestigious scholarship every year.

- 27 % of first-year students receive financial aid
- **2,000** recipients of the Emile Boutmy scholarship over the past 10 years
- €10.2 million set aside for grants and other financial aid
