

PYP-MYP Music Facilitator:

A music instrument facilitator should be an inspirational, passionate and adaptable educator with the ability to deliver an inquiry-based, trans-disciplinary programme. A facilitator of EYP/PYP and/or MYP/DP music and instruments should be an outstanding facilitator, motivator, learner and communicator, with excellent interpersonal skills, and should be capable of preparing students for international programmes in a stimulating, challenging and well-organized learning environment. Also, the music facilitator should be able to provide professional expertise, high quality teaching and learning, make effective use of resources and ensure high standards of learning and achievement for all students.

A graduate subject specialist with a teaching certification. A minimum of three years teaching experience in a reputable institution is preferred. Experience with teaching the specialised programme (EYP/PYP and/or MYP/DP) will be an asset. Dedication to the job, the ARIS core values, subject-specific expertise, student centred teaching approaches, the ability to apply differentiation in the classroom, effective classroom management as well as good relations with students, staff and parents are the qualities sought.

She or He should teach students in a way that will enable them to gain a commitment to, skills in, and a thorough knowledge of Music. Knowledge of playing and teaching more than two musical instruments is a plus.
