- Easy to make german friends on the move






GERMAN CULTURE IS PART OF WORLD HERITAGE











EASY TO LEARN GERMAN

- Easy to learn. German and English share same root
- No new alphabet to learn

German and English share the same Roots



ENGLISH-GERMAN COGNATES

- Several words in German have the same root as similar words in English. This is called a cognate. Some examples below:
- Accent Akzent
- Alone Allein
- Apple Apfel
- Battery Batterie
- Book Buch
- Cat Katze
- Land Land

This similarity with english vocabulary makes it much easier for English speakers to learn German and its good fun spotting the cognates.

German/English Cognates

Cognates and Stress-shift

English	German
ar-ticle	Ar- <i>ti</i> -kel
<i>per</i> -son	Per-son
<i>flex</i> -i-ble	flex- <i>i</i> -bel
<i>sys</i> -tem	Sys-tem
ha- <i>bi-</i> tu-al	ha-bi- <i>tu</i> -ell

Shift the stress to the next syllable.
