An IB Facilitator should be an inspirational, passionate and adaptable educator with the ability to deliver an inquiry-based, trans-disciplinary programme. An IB facilitator should be an outstanding teacher, motivator, learner and communicator, with excellent interpersonal skills, and should be capable of preparing students for international programmes in a stimulating, challenging and well-organized learning environment. Also, the IB facilitator should be able to provide professional expertise, high quality teaching and learning, make effective use of resources and ensure high standards of learning and achievement for all students.

A graduate subject specialist with a teaching certification. A minimum of three years teaching experience in a reputable institution is preferred. Experience with teaching the MYP-IB Diploma Programme will be a requirement. Dedication to the job, the ARIS core values, subject-specific expertise, student centred teaching approaches, the ability to apply differentiation in the classroom, effective classroom management as well as good relations with students, staff and parents are the qualities sought.

She or He should teach students in a way that will enable them to gain a commitment to, skills in, and a thorough knowledge of physics.
