

Personalized Learning Department Coordinator (PLDCO-Primary):

ARIS, as a fully Personalized Learning school, has a vibrant and growing Personalized Learning Department. Classes are fully integrated, following personalized learning and differentiated instruction to tap into the strengths of each student.

Aside from Differentiation which is followed throughout the school, the department also offers a variety of specialized support programmes, depending on a student's need; such as Pull-out support and One-on-one support.

The PLDCs (SENCOs) are in liaison with the Heads of School and the Heads of Department and play a key role in overseeing the implementation of personalized learning programmes to provide children with social, emotional and/or learning needs. PLDC (SENCO) will oversee the day-to-day operation of the PLD policy, will manage, coordinate to establish targets and review progress of the pupils and put in place Personalized Learning Plans (PLPs) for SEND students and Personalized Intervention Plans (PIPs) for students on intervention plans and will regularly review and update it to best support students.
