The creative excuses of students when missing lessons.

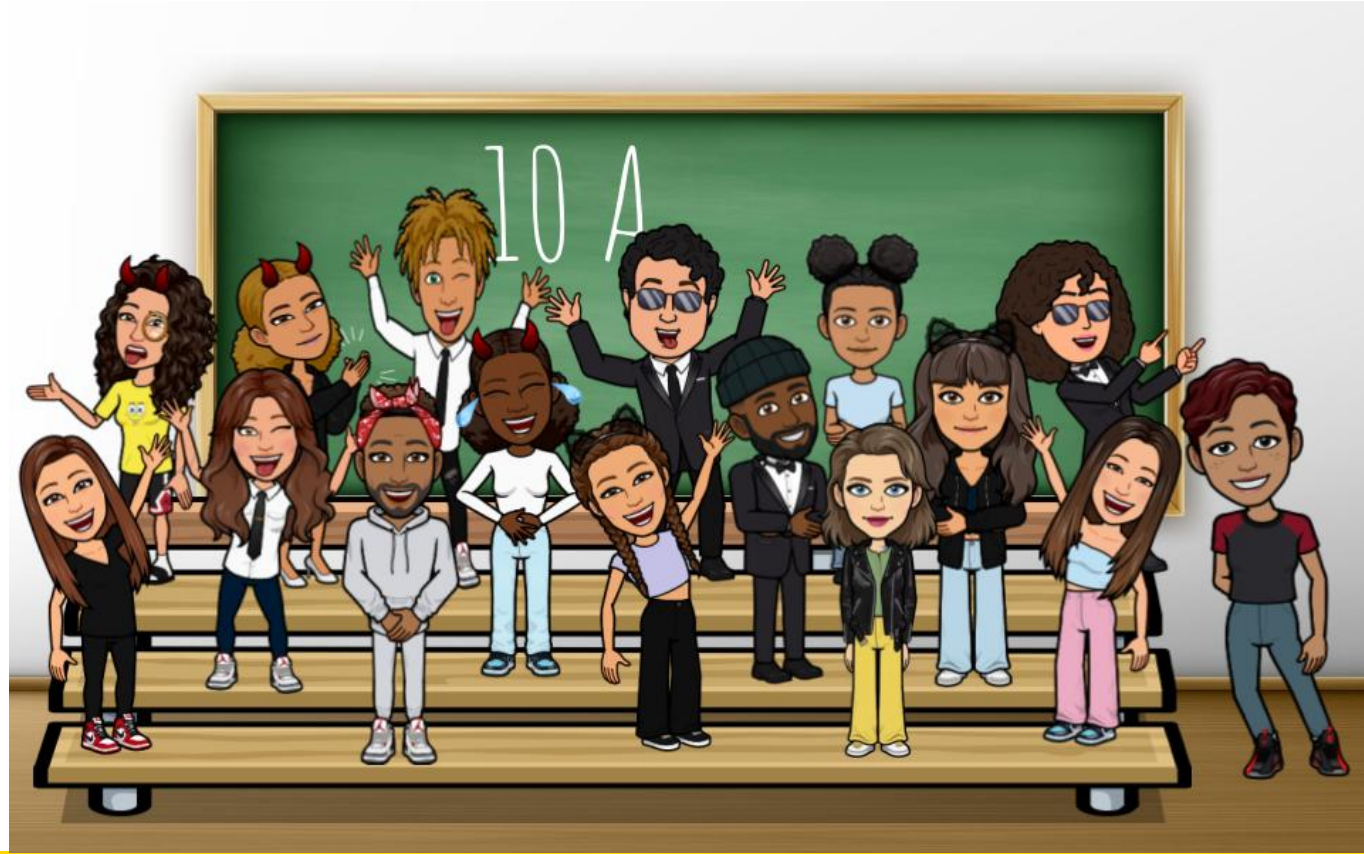
